

## Woolston Eyes - Mosses and Liverworts List rev.01Jan2024

There are around 1067 British species of Mosses and Liverworts (including the related Hornworts) and traditionally classified together in the Division Bryophyta. All are small, simple, plants usually found in moist locations.
